### A Musical Adventure

Once again, Accès Asie will be presenting with "parcours interculturel", Journées de la culture, Gesù- Centre de créativité. At 1p.m. come witness the musical ensemble with Montrealer multi-percussionist Patrick Graham and Taiwanese musician Shuni Tsou, specialist of dizi flutes.

### Patrick Graham and Shuni Tsou

The musical collaboration of Shuni Tsou and Patrick Graham provides the soundtrack of a borderless geographical area. The marriage of the dizi (Chinese flutes in bamboo) with various percussion instruments from all corners of the globe transports the listener to an imaginary country where the resonance of the natural elements such as wood, bamboo, skin, clay and water become animated.

Patrick's percussion repertoire includes: Japanese taïkos, multi-percussions installations and several other percussion instruments originating from various world cultures. Where Patrick lays down the steady "beat of the heart", Shuni answers with a complimentary wind vocabulary of an astonishing diversity.
